PIAG's Benjamin Franklin Award is the highest honor presented in Georgia's printing industry. Past recipients of this award acclaim that this is indeed the highlight of their career. Keeping the significance and prestige of this honor in mind, please take the time to make your choice known. Review the following criteria and forward your nomination to PIAG right away.

The PIAG Benjamin Franklin Award honors an individual for being a long-term major contributor to the graphic arts industry in Georgia. Nominees for this award should meet the following criteria:

- Successful in his or her chosen profession.
- A person of high principles and integrity.
- A person who shares time and talent to work toward the advancement of the printing industry.
- Work for the betterment of society through civic, community, or religious involvements.
- Worked 15 years in the graphic arts industry, with at least five of those years in Georgia.
- Past PIAG Board Chairmen are not eligible for nomination until they have been retired from their chairmanship for at least three years.
